

Dear Friends,

I know I wrote about the following two topics last week in this column but I plan on writing about them for the next couple of weeks. If you missed last week's bulletin, I am referring to the Healing Mass that is going to be hosted at St. Matthew Church on Monday, June 6th at 7pm with Rev. Richard McAlear as the main celebrant.

You might be interested to know that Rev. McAlear is going to be celebrating Healing Masses throughout the week at various local Catholic Churches. One in particular will be at St. Catherine of Siena in Mendon on Tuesday, June 7th at 7 pm

As I explained from the pulpit anyone may attend a mass dedicated to healing. Though we may immediately think it is for someone with a physical ailment it is also for people for looking for a healing in other forms; not only physical but emotional and spiritual healing as well. One person I know who was healed from an infirmity that prevented her from being able to walk told me that she felt the healing for her was being released of the anger she felt about not being able to be the mother she wanted to be to her three teenagers. As she put it being able to walk was simply "the icing on the cake" for her.

One of the things that is very common at masses such as these are people getting "slain in the spirit" which is when after being blessed you immediately fall to the floor (not to worry there are people there to catch you). You do not have to be slain in the spirit to receive a healing. In fact the healing does not have to happen all at once but can also happen over a gradual period of time. If you are looking for a healing of some form in your life I hope you will consider coming to this mass.

Something else I hope you will consider attending will be our first annual St. Mary's/St. Matthew 5K Walk/Run for Fun for our families. That will be June 11th at St. Matthew Church. I know everyone is not into running (including yours truly) but let's face it the warm weather has been taking it's own sweet time getting here and by June 11th we should do something to celebrate it. So if you aren't running, come out and enjoy a hamburger and cheer people on. It will make for a fun morning. Also we could really use some help with volunteers at water stops, registrations, cooking, clean up etc. So think about getting out and just giving a hand and enjoying some time with neighbors and friends.
